- In 1880, it expanded it use include supplying newspapers, agents of Parker's Dye
- In the late 1880s, the Bank of Commerce purchased the property for a new branch
- In 1919, a contractor/builder W. S. Davis. Wiffen acquired this property
- In 1931, A dentist Lloyed A. Jacques bought it who had an office on Trafalgar Rd. The family attended Knox Presbyterian Church & amp; Lloyd was a member of the




LOWER FLOOR (1596 sq.ft.)
